Candidates who intend to stand for the general examinations must submit this form completed to the Director of Graduate Studies no later than the semester *preceding* the one in which the examinations are to be given. The Director of Graduate Studies will verify that all Ph.D. course, language, and examination requirements have been met, all Incompletes in required courses have been removed, and the student is in satisfactory standing. The student, in consultation with the Director of Graduate Studies, will normally propose at least three professors to be on the Examination Committee. Two members of the Committee must be from the Faculty of Arts and Sciences and at least one of them must be from the active ladder faculty of the Slavic Department. Final membership of the Ph.D. Examination Committee is subject to the approval of the Director of Graduate Studies.

The general examinations may be taken by students during the fall or spring semesters, but must be completed by the end of the examination period (no examinations will be given during University recesses or the summer. An interval of up to one month is permitted between the dates of the written and oral examinations.
